OUTCOMES TO BE ASSESSED:

TASK DESCRIPTION:

There are two parts to this assessment task. You are required to complete and submit both parts:

Part A: Creepy Crawley's Sculpture (25 marks)

Students will complete a Creepy Crawley sculpture in class. The sculpture is made using cane and tissue paper. They will use knowledge and skills **developed** in class to guide their selection and application of visual arts conventions and procedures in the making of their artwork. Students will also use their knowledge of the frames to **make** an artwork that extends concepts and different meaning to the audience about their chosen insect or bug.

Part B: Artist Case Study, Louise Bourgeois (25 marks)

Students will study artist Louise Bourgeois and use the source material provided to respond to a series of short answer questions. The questions will require students to **apply** their understanding of practice to explain and interpret the ideas and actions of artist Louise Bourgeois. Students will be provided with a scaffold and time in class to complete the task, however, they can also work on the task at home if they wish.

ASSESSMENT CRITERIA:

Part A: Creepy Crawley's sculpture (25 marks)

Students will be marked on how well they:

- Use art conventions and procedures to **develop** an insect or bug (Creepy Crawley) using cane and tissue paper
- Consider and use the subjective and structural frames to make an artwork that conveys ideas and meanings
- Make a sculpture using form, shape, line and surface treatment to extend and develop meaning in their work
- Resolve and refine their artwork (artwork, art conventions and procedures)

Part B: Artist Case Study (25 marks)

Students will be marked on how well they:

• apply their understanding of practice to explain and interpret the ideas and actions of artist Louise Bourgeois
