### TASK DESCRIPTION:

In Japanese culture, it is expected that you perform a Jikoshoukai (self-introduction) when you first **interact** with someone and **exchange** information with them. In a Jikoshoukai, you typically include information like your name, age, nationality and your hometown, and appropriate greetings at the beginning and the end.

On page 4 of this document, there is a sample Jikoshoukai filled with this information. There is space to translate the Jikoshoukai into Romaji and to translate it into English.

In this task, you need to write a profile to **respond** to the sample profile, in Japanese on the template provided on Page 5. Your profile needs to be **organised** and include the following information:

- Your name
- Your age
- Your nationality
- Your hometown
- Appropriate greetings

Your Jikoshoukai needs to **demonstrate** your understanding of Japanese characters and be written completely in Japanese script, and you need to **apply** appropriate grammatical structures in Japanese

(it needs to be written in full sentences). Typed responses will be accepted if previously discussed with your teacher. Your task needs to be submitted during class in the following periods:

7 Language B = Friday 12<sup>th</sup> May period 4

7 Language N = Friday 12<sup>th</sup> May period 3

7 Language C = Friday 12<sup>th</sup> May period 1

7 Language W = Friday 12<sup>th</sup> May period 1

7 Language G = Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> May period 3

7 Language M = Friday 12<sup>th</sup> May period 2

You should find all of the information that you need for this assessment in your workbook or booklet.
