TASK DESCRIPTION:

This task is a final examination set up to cover all of the content from your Year 11 Japanese Beginners

There are two parts to this task:

Part 1: Written and Aural Examination (70 marks)

During the examination period you will sit an exam that covers all of the skills and content that you have learnt this year. It will first have a listening component during the exam where you will listen to a

track and answer questions about it, and respond to it in English and Japanese. It will also consist of reading and comprehension questions and writing activities.

During the listening and reading sections, you will be expected to **convey** the gist of the passages, or **identify** specific information from the passage, and you will also be expected to **identify** and **explain** aspects of Japanese culture that is evident in the listening or reading texts.

In the writing section, you need to **establish** and **maintain** communication in Japanese, **manipulating** Japanese grammar to **produce** an appropriate text in Japanese.

Part 2: Spoken Conversation (20 marks)

You will need to **establish** and **maintain** communication in Japanese with your teacher, **applying** your knowledge of Japanese culture. You will then be asked a series of questions by your teacher that are on the following content:

- Typical Jikoshoukai information (age, nationality, hometown, family, pets, etc)
- School subjects
- Likes and dislikes
- Sports, hobbies, spare time and childhood activities

You are expected to apply your knowledge of Japanese vocabulary and grammar to answer these questions as fluently and as detailed as possible. Your responses are expected to be from memory, and the use of aizuchi (conversational interjections) are permitted where necessary.

There is a list of questions that may be used during this conversation on page 6 of this document. This list will of questions be provided to you on the day of the conversation to use.

- Answers to the listening comprehension questions
- Answers to the reading comprehension questions
- Written responses (including layout, grammar, vocabulary and characters)
- Conversation (including fluency, grammar, vocabulary and overall content)
