<b>TASK DESCRIPTION:</b> In this task you will be required to write a description of a monster in full sentences using the Japanese language. This description needs to talk about your monster's name, physical appearance, its likes and dislikes, and its favourite things. You will be <b>applying</b> Japanese grammar to <b>compose</b> this description of your monster and to <b>convey</b> all of the necessary information. There is a profile page on page 5 for you to fill in and submit. The profile needs to be hand-written completely in Japanese script and in full sentences. There is a sample profile to read through and translate. This will be done in class and is not marked.  Access your booklet, workbook, and any work on Canvas (particularly body parts, colours, describing monsters, likes and dislikes and favourite things) to help you complete this task. You are allowed to submit a draft of this task, but that is expected to be submitted before Tuesday 22nd August, for you to receive and properly implement feedback. Drafts can be submitted to your teacher on paper, or via Canvas. Any evidence of plagiarism (this includes, but is not limited to, Google Translate) will result in a zero mark for the plagiarised section, and you being asked to resubmit those parts of the task.
