OUTCOMES TO BE ASSESSED:

TASK DESCRIPTION:

Students will have 3 hours and 5 minutes to complete the examination. Attempt all sections of the examination, including Sections I, II and III.

Section I - Multiple Choice

20 marks

- This section has 20 multiple choice questions, a mixture of skills based questions and content knowledge based questions
- Some questions will refer to the stimulus booklet provided
- Attempt Questions 1-20 on the separate answer sheet provided
- Allow about 30 minutes for this section.

Section II - Short Answer questions

40 marks

- This section contains a mixture of skills based and content knowledge short answer questions
- Some guestions will refer to the stimulus booklet provided
- Allow about 1 hour and 10minutes for this section

Section III – Extended Responses

40 marks

- This section has 2 extended response questions
- Each extended response is 20 marks
- Select 2 questions from the 3 options provided
- Allow about 1 hour and 15 minutes for this section

The task will be completed under examination conditions.

ASSESSMENT CRITERIA:

The trial will be assessing the student's ability to identify, describe, **explain**, **evaluate**, **justify**, **analyse** and **communicate** Geographical information. Students will be required to demonstrate their understanding of Geographical theory by **applying** it to the stimulus provided.
