TOPIC: Australians at War Examination

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

OUTCOMES TO BE ASSESSED:

HT5-1 Explains and **assesses** the historical forces and factors that shaped the modern world and Australia.

HT5-2 Sequences and **explains** the significant patterns of continuity and change in the development of the modern world and Australia.

HT5-4 Explains and **analyses** the cause and effects of events and developments in the modern world

DIRECTIONAL VERBS:

Explain: Relate cause and effect; make the relationships between things evident; provide why and/or how.

Assess: Make a judgement of value, quality or outcome.

Analyses: Identify components and the relationship between them; draw out and relate implications

TASK DESCRIPTION: You will have 55 minutes to complete the examination under formal conditions. You **MUST** complete all three sections.

Section I: Definition Match-up (4 Marks)

Demonstrate your understanding of the **MAIN** causes of WW1 by matching the correct terms with their definition.

Section II: TOMACU (11 Marks)

You are to **analyse** ONE of the two provided sources by completing the TOMAC scaffold You are required to **assess** how the source provided can help you to answer the historical question in section III. In this section, you must address the following elements for the source:

- Type
- Origin
- Motive
- Audience
- Content
- Usefulness

Section III: Written Response (10 marks)

Using the information gained from Section II and your own knowledge, write an extended response to the answer the historical question below:

*With direct reference to your chosen source from Source A **OR** Source B, **explain** the factors that contributed to the outbreak of WW1.*

ASSESSMENT CRITERIA:

You will be assessed on your ability to apply historical understanding in ALL three sections of the examination.

SECTION I: In the Definition Match-up (4 Marks)

- Allow 5 minutes
- Match correct definitions to the correct term

SECTION II: In the TOMACU source analysis (11 Marks)

- Allow 20 minutes
- Attempt ALL questions
- Complete the TOMACU source analyse by answering the questions on ONE of the two provided sources

SECTION III: In the written response (10 Marks)

- Allow 30 minutes
- Include an introduction, body paragraphs (PEEL) and a conclusion
- Make direct reference to the source chosen in section II throughout your response.
